School Updates with Principal Dr. Carey:

- This year, the school's primary focus has been to help kids get back to the normal routines in the classroom, and help them learn at high levels.

Past Event Updates

- Book Fair
 - Grossed close to \$15,000 in sales during the Scholastic Book Fair held in March. The Executive Board unanimously voted to turn 100% of our profit (\$6,435) into Scholastic dollars. ARSHSA will coordinate with Ms. Sue Herndon, the reading specialist, on dedicating most of these funds to the scholastic news magazine at Dr. Carey's request.
- Gertrude Hawk
 - Grossed nearly \$10,000 in sales, netting almost \$5,000 for the school, offsetting the cost of transportation for the 6th grade field trip to Forest Lodge.
- STEM Summit
 - The committee developed STEM activities covering a variety of topics and the kids had a really enjoyable time last month.
- Drama Club Event
 - ARSHSA volunteers sold snacks and water during the event and over \$1K was raised through the sale of tickets to parents of ARIS students.
 - Close to \$1400 will be going back into the school to help support the club needs in the future.
- Dine Outs (The Landing April 21)
 - Our last dine out of the year took place at The Landing last week, April 21. Auten Road benefits with 20% of our sales being donated back to the school.
 - No results yet to share.
