School Updates with Principal Dr. Carey

- Forest Lodge contribution from ARSHSA helped us keep costs down for students to participate. This trip is Wednesday June 8
- Carnival is coming up, and we are excited to share more details as the event gets closer. June 15, rain date June 16.
- 4th Graders / incoming Auten Road has been welcoming each elementary school during the school day over the last week for a tour and session with Dr. Carey.
- Open House at ARIS Monday August 29, 10-2pm. But on the first day, students do not move classes, all students are taking tours around the building and acclimated to the school set up.
- 6th graders are transitioning to middle school they used to take a trip to the middle school, but they are going to try something new this year
 - The visit will be taking place in August one for each grade level. It will likely be around the same time as ARIS, around August 29 and 30.
 - Student Council representatives will present to homerooms at ARIS for soon to be rising 7th graders and will be visiting June 13.
- 7th grade placements (literacy and math) final details are being worked out and should be available in the Genesis portal Friday, June 3, the latest on Monday, June 6. This will be available in the portal for several days.
- Some questions were raised about the recent IOWA testing. How much does the test score count in placement? What is the minimal percentile needed for Algebra I? Dr. Carey said pertinent

details will be provided in the letter that will be sent out when the Genesis Portal placement is released.

- Are the same percent placing into Algebra I as in the past? It's typically 5% of students that are Algebra ready at the end of 6th grade.
- Chromebook collection will be as late as possible in the school year. Likely the last two full days of school, June 15 and 16. After that, they start the locker clean up likely the last Friday, June 17
- A 15 minute slideshow set to music assembled by the staff and teachers will be shared with students on the last day of school. Then transition to a yearbook signing session.
