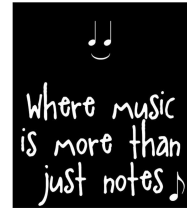




Auten Road Intermediate School Instrumental Music Department

Each year, Hillsborough 4th grade students have the opportunity to become a part of the exciting world of instrumental music by joining the band or orchestra in Grade 5! Learning to play a musical instrument can be one of the most enriching of all school experiences with multiple academic and social benefits.

Any child can learn to play a musical instrument, as long as they are committed, supported and have a positive attitude! Those who put forth a good effort will always succeed and we will help them to develop their musical talents.

Parents often ask which instrument is best for their child. Even though there are many factors, such as the child’s physical features and the size of the instrument, generally it is the one he/she most wants to play. Parents will be provided an instrument recommendation plus rental information after the instrument trial. ♪ ARIS INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM INFORMATION ♪

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| Eligibility: | Any child entering 5 th grade may sign up for the beginning instrumental program. |
| Instruction: | <p>The ARIS Instrumental Music Program is comprised of two instructional components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Small group lessons for given instruments ➤ Big band/big orchestra (full ensemble) practices <p><u>Small Group Lessons:</u> At ARIS, your child will have Physical Education/Health classes scheduled five days per week. One day per week your child will attend their small group lesson instead of their Physical Education/Health class.</p> <p><u>Big Band/Big Orchestra/Full Ensemble Practice:</u> Your child will attend a full ensemble practice during one class period each Monday. This class period will rotate among mathematics, literacy, social studies and science classes to minimize impact upon their instruction. Fifth grade teachers are aware of Monday being a day on which several students attend full ensemble practices. While teachers are not expected to stop or slow the pacing of instruction, they are supportive of students developing responsibility in balancing their learning in both academics and instrumental music. Students are expected to approach their teacher after missing this class time in order to have an accurate description of what classwork or assignments need to be made up (<i>please see “Expectations Related to Students in Instrumental Music”</i>). Students must participate in both small group lessons and their full ensemble.</p> |
| Instruments: | <p>Instruction will be given on all band and string instruments offered at the instrument trial sessions. A beginning student should have an instrument of good quality in order to ensure progress (<i>in case of an older, used instrument, it is advised that you take it to a repair shop to assure that it is in good playing condition</i>).</p> <p>Parents are responsible for providing the instrument, lesson book, and accessories.</p> <p>In cases of financial hardship, contact an ARIS instrumental music teacher for assistance.</p> |
| Commitment Policy: | The ARIS Instrumental Music Team strongly believes in teaching commitment and dedication through music education/performance. Because this curriculum is designed as a full year learning experience, we highly recommend that each students join the program with the intention of completing the school year. |
| ARIS Expectations Related to Students in Instrumental Music: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ On big band/big orchestra days, students are responsible to ask the teacher in person about any missed work AFTER the missed period but before the end of the day. ARIS teachers are very accommodating of instrumental students. ➤ If a student is missing his/her instrument, they are still expected to attend the scheduled practice. ➤ Students must take their instruments home at the end of each day. ➤ All Students must purchase an Instrumental Music T-Shirt (\$5) for concerts. |

♪ Recommendations for Instrument Rentals & Services ♪

A **quality** instrument is an integral part to your child's success, we highly recommend the following vendors who provide the best instruments and service to our students. Students who use higher quality instruments always have an advantage in tone and ease of use. We recommend renting versus purchasing to our beginners as renting provides a much higher quality at a lower cost. We are very satisfied with the **quality** of instruments, the competitive **prices** that they offer, and the level of **service** they provide to our district on a weekly basis. Both companies listed below make weekly visits to ARIS and provide repair and replacement services to our students without inconveniencing families. While many companies offer a 4 ½ month trial period, **we highly recommend committing your child to the full school year** and choosing the 10 month rental. The 10 month rental is also the most cost effective plan available. You are not obligated to use the services of the recommended companies but we request if you choose a different vendor that you contact your ARIS Instrumental Music liaison teacher.

All Students will also need a lesson book for class. Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Baritone and Percussion students will be using **Tradition of Excellence Book 1**. All String students will be using **Orchestra Expressions Book 1**.
