

ARIS Student Materials Pick-Up / Drop-Off June 10 & 11

June 10 (5th Grade) & June 11 (6th Grade)

*****NEW*** - FAQs / Reminders**

What do I need to do in preparation for June 10 & 11 pick-up / drop-off? Together with your child please locate any materials that belong to ARIS, including textbooks, library materials, and novels. You may have already received an email from our librarian and/or your child's teachers regarding specific items that need to be returned.

Are chromebooks going to be collected on June 10 & 11? Chromebooks will not be collected on June 10 and 11. Chromebook collection will take place at the high school after June 16. Please be on the lookout for a separate correspondence regarding chromebooks.

Do students need to come to ARIS on June 10 / 11? Because we are asking that an adult take the lead for pick-up / drop-off, students are certainly not required to come to school. However, if students do accompany a parent/guardian, we do as that they remain in the vehicle.

What about PPE / Social Distancing Expectations? The parent/guardian involved with drop-off / pick-up will need to wear a mask. Also, please be sure to maintain social distancing of at least six feet at all times.

Can I send an adult friend or family member to pick-up / drop-off for me? Yes, we certainly understand the challenges that may result from conducting pick-up / drop-off during school and work hours.

Will I be required to enter the school and go to my child's locker? All lockers will be emptied, bagged, tagged with the student's name, and ready to hand back at the time of your arrival.

Important Reminder: Please remember to drive carefully on school grounds and be especially aware of your speed, other vehicles, and other individuals. Your patience is also appreciated. Please refer to the diagram on page two for pick-up / drop-off points around the school.

PROCEDURES

1. Pick-up / drop-off student materials will take place on June 10 (grade 5) and June 11 (grade 6) between the hours of 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. at ARIS each day according to the schedule below:

2. **Medicine Pick-Up** will take place at the main entrance. A table will be set up outside of the main entrance doors under the portico. Families in need of medicine pick-up will stop along the curb at the front entrance. Please remain in your vehicle. A school nurse will come to the vehicle to gather information and provide your medication directly to you.
3. **Personal Belongings Pick-Up and School Materials Drop-Off** will take place from the rear parking lot. Vehicles should park in a lined spot and a parent / guardian should proceed to the back entrance to the cafe. Students should remain in the vehicle.
4. Staff (wearing masks & maintaining social distance) will be on hand to retrieve student's personal belongings that have been bagged / tagged and organized in the cafe.
5. This will also be the location to return band/orchestra instruments, library books, classroom books/textbooks and other school / teacher issued materials. Teachers will do their best to send out a reminder email to specific students regarding outstanding items. Regardless, we greatly appreciate your diligence in securing school items from home and bringing those to school on June 10 or 11.
6. Items retrieved from classrooms and hallways that are not labeled will be placed in our general "lost and found." The lost and found can be accessed on June 10 & 11. Please ask a staff member for assistance when you arrive!
