<p>Instruction/Ensemble Rehearsal Rotations:</p>	<p>The ARIS Instrumental Music Program is comprised of two instructional components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Small group lessons for given instruments ➤ Big band/big orchestra (full ensemble) practices <p>Students will receive instruction for these components as described below:</p> <p>Small Group Lessons: At ARIS, students will have Physical Education/Health classes scheduled five days per week. One day per week instrumental music students will attend a small group lesson instead of their Physical Education/Health class.</p> <p>Big Band/Big Orchestra(Full Ensemble Practice): Students will attend a full ensemble practice during one class period each week. 5th grade students will attend ensemble on Mondays, and 6th grade students will attend ensemble on Fridays.</p> <p>When possible, this class period will rotate among mathematics, literacy, social studies and science classes to minimize impact upon instruction. Classroom teachers should expect that on rehearsal days several students will attend full ensemble practices. For planning purposes, rehearsal rotation schedules will be provided to all staff in September.</p>
<p>ARIS Expectations Related to Students in Instrumental Music:</p> <p>(to be reinforced in class-academic and instrumental)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ On big band/big orchestra days, students are responsible to ask the teacher in person about any missed work AFTER the missed period but before the end of the day. Students should not check in with the teacher during lunch or recess. ➤ If a student is missing his/her instrument, they are still expected to attend the scheduled practice. ➤ Students are expected to arrive to classes on time. ➤ Students must take their instruments home at the end of each day.
