## ♪ COURSE OFFERINGS PER GRADE LEVEL/EXPERIENCE LEVEL ♪

To select courses, all families must **complete a google form which will be sent via email** shortly *after* enrolling on Hillsborough Recreation Community Pass. Schedules will be sent via email no later than **June 28th, 2019**.

### BEGINNING STUDENTS

All students going into grade 5 or new to an instrument. *Level - no experience.*

*\*Please note that the summer program does not include piano or guitar lessons.*

All students entering grade 5 will be scheduled for a 40 minute group lesson, a 40 minute ensemble period (Beginning Band or Beginning Orchestra), and an hour and a half of Music Enrichment!

\*Beginning students who have not yet experienced the Auten Road Intermediate School Instrumental Music Department Recruitment mouthpiece testing (*May or June*) are permitted to sign up early. However, it is highly recommended to sign up for instrument choice of **“to be determined”** on Community Pass. \*

The Summer Music Staff will collaborate with ARIS to add instrument choice *after* the best instrument fit has been determined.

### INTERMEDIATE STUDENTS

*Level - 1 or 2 years of experience. This group will contain two levels - upcoming 6th and 7th graders.*

#### Level One - Students entering grade 6 or 1 year of experience:

Level one Intermediate Students will participate in Intermediate Wind Ensemble, Intermediate Orchestra or Percussion Ensemble.

For the 2 additional periods, students may choose:

- Beginning lesson or beginning ensemble review
- One/two periods of music theory 1.

#### Level Two - Students entering grade 7 or 2 year of experience:

Level two Intermediate Students will participate in Intermediate Wind Ensemble, Intermediate Orchestra or Percussion Ensemble.

For the 2 additional periods, students may choose:

- Beginner on a new instrument or beginning ensemble,
- Jazz Ensemble/Improvisation (*for winds only, no rhythm section*)
- Strings Style Exploration (*pop, jazz, rock, etc.*)
- Music Theory 1 or Music Theory 2-3.



## ADVANCED STUDENTS

*Level 3 and up! This group will generally range from upcoming 8th through 12th graders.*

### Level One - Students entering grade 8-10

Students will be assigned to Advanced Wind Ensemble, Advanced Orchestra or Percussion Ensemble for two periods.

For the 2 additional periods, students may choose:

- Beginning lesson or beginning ensemble on a new instrument
- A review of concepts in Intermediate Ensemble or group lesson
- Music Theory 1 or 2-3
- Jazz Ensemble/Improvisation (*for winds only, no rhythm section*)
- Strings Style Exploration (*pop, jazz, rock, etc.*)

### Level Two - Students entering grade 11 - 12

Students will be assigned to Advanced Wind Ensemble, Advanced Orchestra or Percussion Ensemble for two periods.

For the 2 additional periods, students may choose:

- Beginning lesson or beginning ensemble on a new instrument
- A review of concepts in Intermediate Ensemble or group lesson
- Music Theory 1 or 2-3
- Jazz Ensemble/Improvisation (*for winds only, no rhythm section*)
- Strings Style Exploration (*pop, jazz, rock, etc.*)
- Apprentice Teaching (*only for students interested in a career in Music Education*)
- Beginning Band student mentor

*HHS Student Program Volunteers are accepted into the program with a recommendation from HHS Band and Orchestra Directors.*
